Year 8 Pathways Evening: Tuesday 6th March 2018

We are delighted to invite you to attend our Pathways Evening, where we will explain the process for your children as they move into the next phase of their educational journey at Stationers' Crown Woods Academy. As I am sure you are aware, there have been many changes in education in recent years, with reformed qualifications in all subjects at Key Stage 4, new grading and assessment systems. We would like to explain all of this to you and your child and help them to make the very best decisions for this important next phase.

Our KS4 pathways evening is on **Tuesday 6th March, from 5.30pm**. There is a lot of information to share so we do strongly encourage all Parents and Carers to attend with their children.

At this event you will be able to find out the answers to these and many other questions:

- Which subjects are compulsory for all students?

Please do note that whilst we will do everything possible to accommodate preferred subjects, this may not be possible in some cases due to constraints which emerge when choices for the whole year group are considered holistically. We will explain all of this on the night.
