

GCSE MEDIA STUDIES EXAM AND REVISION INFORMATION

Component 1: Exploring the Media

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes 40% of qualification

Section A: Exploring Media Language and Representation

This section assesses media language and representation in relation to **two** of the following print media forms: magazines, marketing (film posters), newspapers, or print advertisements.

There are **two** questions in this section:

- One question assessing media language in relation to one set product (reference to relevant contexts may be required)
- One two-part question assessing representation in relation to one set product and one unseen resource in the same media form.
 - o Part (a) is based on media contexts.
 - o Part (b) requires comparison through an extended response.

Section B: Exploring Media Industries and Audiences

This section assesses **two** of the following media forms: film, newspapers, radio, video games.

It includes:

- One stepped question on media industries
- One stepped question on audiences.

Component 2: Understanding Media Forms and Products

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes 30% of qualification

This component assesses all areas of the theoretical framework and contexts of the media in relation to television and music.

Section A: Television

- One question on either media language or representation, which will be based on an
- extract from one of the set television programme episodes to be viewed in the examination
- (reference to relevant contexts may be required)
- One question on media industries, audiences or media contexts.

Section B: Music (music videos and online media)

- One question on either media language or representation (reference to relevant contexts
- may be required)
- One question on media industries, audiences or media contexts.


Tips for success

- Understand the four areas of media studies: Media Language, Representation and Contexts, Audience and Industry
- Understand what is on each paper
- Know each set text thoroughly
- Organise folder into Components and Sections
- Review notes and classwork regularly
- Catch up on missed lessons

Suggested revision ideas:

- Retrieval mind maps from memory then revising with other methods and repeating retrieval mind maps regularly after revision
- Create revision cards and maps
- Complete revision clocks both with notes and without (available on shared drive)

- Use Home revision learning guide (located on the students shared drive)
- Use knowledge organiser for quizzes and learning essential information

- Revisit/re- watch set texts
