Now that the government expects that all young people will continue in education or training until the age of 18 these choices are more important than ever. Whatever your son/daughters interests or aspirations there are opportunities available in Royal Greenwich and the event aims to make sure that each young person is well informed to make the right choices.

On the day, students will be expected to arrive at school on time, in their full school uniform. The school day will be reorganised to ensure all Year 11 students have lunch as normal. Coaches will be used to transport students to and from the venue.
