<b>Subject:</b> Art
<b>Topic Title:</b> Issues Based
<b>Brief Summary of Content Studied:</b> In this unit students will be introduced to political art and art that carries a political message.Students will explore a variety of issues including War , revolution,race, gender and remembrance by studying the work of Banksy, Kathy Kollwitz , Kara Walker, Barbra Kruger and others.They will experiment with different printmaking techniques and how to create text that conveys a message.
